Download rubygems 1.3.7 from <a href="https://rubygems.org/pages/download">https://rubygems.org/pages/download</a> then extract it. 3. Install rubygems with 'ruby setup.rb' 4. Download zlib 1.1.4-1 from <a href="http://jarp.does.network.org/win32/">http://jarp.does.network.org/win32/</a> then extract it on the side of ruby.exe. !!! IT'S AWFULLY OLD but it's OK for this purpose !!! 5. Run the command above.  According to <a href="https://jira.codehaus.org/browse/JRUBY-5226">https://jira.codehaus.org/browse/JRUBY-5226</a>, 1.9.1 fails as well but trunk (for 1.9.3 at present) is OK (runs clean without error). =end</pre>
