It seems that stdarg.h is included in many separate C files unconditionally:  
array.c, class.c, error.c, sprintf.c, include/ruby/ruby.h, include/ruby/encoding.h - all includes stdarg.h without checking for HAVE\_STDARG\_PROTOTYPES

So that, why there is check in include/ruby/intern.h, vm\_core.h, vsnprintf.c (and may be somewhere else)
