With the definition of <code><=></code> on Object on post 1.8, the <code>range_init()</code> function no more throws "ArgumentError: bad value for range" when creating these ranges: nil..nil false..false true..true	
These kind of ranges are meaningless, the majority of methods on Range do not work on them, like <code>(nil..nil).include?(nil)</code> .	
This feature request (with patch) re-introduces the 1.8 behaviour of throwing ArgumentError when creating such ranges.
