<p>Continuing my focus on getting RSS documented, I believe that large amounts of it should be nodoc'd. The vast majority of the code is actually internal implementation detail; the big stuff is the builder DSL, which isn't really served by API-level documentation.</p> <p>The attached patch nodocs everything that's in the top-level files, those being the ones for the specific formats. If it's agreed that most of the rest should be nodoc'd as well, I can do that in another patch, or if we do want api-level docs for all of this, I can work on actually writing those.</p>
